REGULATIONS

on conducting Cambridge Mile 2024

GENERAL PROVISIONS:

The Cambridge Mile aims to promote a healthy lifestyle. The main objectives are:

- Development and popularization of a healthy lifestyle;
- Promotion of Olympic sports in the region;
- Enhancing the athletic skills of participants;
- Encouraging children to participate in running.

This document serves as an official invitation for athletes, including those from other countries, to participate in the competition.

TIME AND VENUE:

- Registration is available on http://cambridgemile.com/ until April 20, 2024.
- Starter packs can be collected on April 25-26, 2024, at the Cambridge International School or on April 27, 2024, at the F.N. Rusanov Botanical Garden in Tashkent.
- The briefing takes place on April 27, 2024, at the F.N. Rusanov Botanical Garden.
- The competition date is April 27, 2024, with start times at 10:30 and 11:30 at the Botanical Garden.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE:

- The judging panel operates in Russian and Uzbek;
- Briefings are in Russian with translations available in English and Uzbek;
- Announcements during the races are made 50% in Russian and 50% in Uzbek, with English translations provided if necessary.

ORGANIZERS:

The event is organized by the Cambridge International School and the Triathlon Federation of Uzbekistan.

AGE CATEGORIES:

Participants from the age of three are welcome.

PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS:

- A maximum of 500 participants is allowed.
- Registration must be completed online at http://cambridgemile.com/.
- Participants must provide insurance at the time of collecting their starter packs.
- Participants without prior registration and insurance will not be admitted.

Participants are responsible for the accuracy of the registration details they provide.

STARTER PACK:

Registered participants must collect their starter pack in person, which includes a race number, pins, T-shirt, and chip.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

The competition involves a running distance of 1 mile, taking place in the Botanical Garden.

REGULATIONS, LIMITS, AND TIMING:

- The course layout is provided in Appendix №3.
- The event may be canceled or postponed due to natural disasters or other force majeure circumstances.

SAFETY:

Medical assistance will be provided by the Ministry of Health, and the National Guard will ensure safety at the event.
